The silk thread is supplied by the Chinese, while the gold and silver threads are given by the Indians, who are processed and transformed into songket by the Palembang people. At the time, the songket craft was a sideline for Palembang's indigenous people. Originally, songket was only worn by men as a tanjak or headband. Over time, the women began to wear songket sarongs with *kurung* clothes. However, in Palembang culture, songket cloth is now generally used on formal events, for example at weddings. Currently songket already exists in various regions with various motives. Because of that, many people have different opinions about the origin of songket. As a result, it would be good if songket were introduced as Palembang traditional cloth. This is done so that people will know that songket originated in Palembang.

Songket as Palembang traditional cloth can be promoted in a variety of ways. People usually promote something through magazines, booklets, newspaper, storybook, etc. Here the writer wants to give information about songket through a comic. In addition to being a promotional medium, comic can also make readers feel entertained by the stories inside.
