

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION**

This chapter presents the conclusions and suggestion related to the study.

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

The comic story entitled "Woven Gold" is written for promoting *Songket* as traditional cloth from Palembang. There were five steps in writing the comic story. The stages written by Rahayu (2015) are linked with research and development method modification developed by Sukmadinata (2019). In preliminary study it was linked with making a synopsis, describing the characters, dividing the scene into panels, explaining the situation, and writing the dialogue. In the second step, there were two testing in model development: limited testing and wider testing. In limited testing, the content and language were being tested by two experts. In content the expert suggested the writer to correct some dialogue text and explanation of the situation in the narration. In English, the expert found some mistakes in grammar, italicization, capitalization, and word choice. After the writer revised the first draft that being tested in limited testing, the second draft model of comic story were being tested again in wider field testing. In wider testing, the content and language were also tested by two experts who really masters in that field. In content the expert suggested the writer to summarize some dialogue texts that were too long. In English the expert found some mistakes in grammar, punctuation, and word choice. After doing revision in wider testing, the product is considered as the final product. The writer did not conduct the final product testing and dissemination due to the lack of cost, time, legality, and skill.

#### **5.2 Suggestion**

Based on the result of this study, the writer suggests that the next researchers complete the final stage of Research and Development, that is the final product and dissemination in order to determine the effectiveness of the products made.
