

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1. Conclusions

Public speaking influenced the alumni of English Department, Sriwijaya State Polytechnic in getting a job. This was supported by the results of a questionnaires that revealed the influence of public speaking in getting a job for the alumni of English Department of State Polytechnic of Sriwijaya reaching 85,04%. The result of the questionnaires was also supported by the percentage of public speaking scores owned by 60 Respondents which indicates that there were 25 respondents who have “A” as the score of public speaking and 27 respondents who have “B” as the score of public speaking with the total percentage is 86%.

5.2. Suggestions

Based on the research results and conclusions, the writer can provide the following suggestions:

a. For the Students

Students can improve public speaking skills, confidence, and communication skills by active participated in class discussions, questions, submit opinions and participate in training forums public speaking. In addition, students can also practice in organizations such as BEM, MPM, UKM or other community both in campus and outside campus to be able to improve public speaking skills, confidence and communication skills.

b. For the English Department

Good public speaking skills can be a provision for personal and social careers, but not everyone has the public speaking skill. Therefore, education and public speaking training need to be improved by students.
