CHAPTER I

Novella can also be used to promote tourism objects. In Indonesia, there are still not many Indonesian writers who write novella in English prose, so there is still a lack of enthusiasm for readers to read novella in English prose. However, English novella is not very popular among the public, especially in Indonesia.

Thus, hopefully, novella in English prose are expected to increase the mastery and interest of readers to be interested in the English language.

In addition, Laskar Pelangi which is a local story that successfully raised the name of Belitung Island. Actually, the Laskar Pelangi is not for promotion, but they indirectly promote the tourism objects which are full of limitations based on real conditions in Belitung or true stories novelist at the time. Laskar Pelangi has been translated into at least 26 languages in the world. Since Laskar Pelangi has been noticed by people around the world, Belitung has become one of the cities visited by many tourists because Laskar Pelangi readers are curious about the places. According to Badan Pusat Statistik (English: The Central Bureau of Statistic) of Bangka Belitung Province, the number of tourists visiting Bangka-Belitung island has increased rapidly. During 2011-2017, the average tourist increased by 29 percent. It was recorded that tourist visits reached 380.941 people in 2017. The amount of pages in the novella is not too many, so that it is light to read. Through the places in the story, readers tend to join in their imagination and they can know the representative of the places. Moreover, novella that raise tourist destinations are rarely found, especially with Palembang as the setting places that are put into the story.

Therefore, the writer is interested in writing a final report entitle "Designing A Novella Script Entitled "99 Days"" with the romance genre that is one of the most favorite genres in teenagers.
