

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion based on the results of the research.

5.1 Conclusion

As a result of the study, The existence of forest areas in Bukit Kaba Tourism Destinations is very important in supporting the sustainability of Kaba Hill natural tourism activities. Forests are home to various types of flora and fauna, a source of cool air in this area, and an important ornament in the regional landscape mosaic. The entire "service" of the forest to the natural tourism of Kaba Hill makes this forest block mandatory to be preserved. The diversity of flora in Kaba Hill is an attractive sight for every tourist who crosses the trail route to the top of the Kaba hill. There are many types of flora found in the Kaba Hill Tourism Destination including types of pairs, tubers, pandanus thorns, rafflesia flowers (*Rafflesia arnoldii*), carrion flowers (*Amorphopallus titanum*) and types of natural orchids. Likewise with fauna. The existence of wild animals in the forest area of Kaba Hill Tourism Destination is influenced by the hill forest ecosystem

Kaba Hill is still conducive as a place to live and breed various types of wild animals. The existence of diverse flora in Kaba Hill is very dependent on the integrity of the forest area of the Kaba Hill Tourism Destination so that its security and sustainability must really be a priority scale that must be carried out by the manager of the Kaba Hill Tourism Destination.

5.2 Suggestion

After seeing the result of study, The Bukit Kaba Tourism Destination Area has ecotourism potential in the form of attractive natural resources, adequate accessibility, supportive legal status and forestry regulations, active role and full support of the community, supportive environmental conditions, and strategic geographical location. There are several steps that according to the author can be taken for the development of ecotourism in Bukit Kaba including developing more varied tourism programs, improving infrastructure, promoting effective and well-programmed promotions, conducting better quality and effective coordination and cooperation between the parties.

The success of Bukit Kaba ecotourism development can be achieved if there is an integration between the power of the community, government, mass media, NGOs, and the private sector. So that tourist activities in Bukit Kaba can still be of interest, the steps that should be taken are securing and comforting the area around the sulfur crater, improving trekking routes, maintaining the integrity of the Kaba hill forest area, fixing and optimizing the campsite facilities, making pools for adequate hot springs and the last is conserving and breeding bird species originating from the Bukit Kaba Tourism Destination area.
