

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

In Nelson Mandela's speeches, the writer concludes that Nelson Mandela delivered four types of speech. Those are *Special occasion*, *Inspirational speech*, *Informative speech* and *Persuasive speech*. The most dominant speech delivered by Nelson Mandela is **special occasion** speech which has 11 frequencies or 55 percentages. The second is *Inspirational speech*, he tried to make his speech memorable impression by saying Inspirational statement. The others are *Informative speech* (3 frequencies and 15 percentages) and *Persuasive speech* (2 frequencies and 10 percentages).

In delivering speech conclusion, Nelson Mandela applied five methods. Those are *making dramatic statement*, *calling to action*, *telling a story*, *using a quotation and summarizing speech*. The most dominant method is *making dramatic statement* which has 8 frequencies or 40 percentages of total methods. The next method is *calling to action* which has 7 frequencies and 35 percentages. *Telling a story* is the third method applied by Nelson Mandela which has 3 frequencies and 15 percentages. The others are *using a quotation and summarizing speech* which has 1 frequency and 5 percentages.

5.2 Suggestion

The writer suggests that when the students, especially students of English Department at State Polytechnic of Sriwijaya apply various types of speech, they should use methods of delivering speech conclusion in order to increase their public speaking skills and to make an interesting speech, so the audience will be interested in the speech and the speech can be memorable and impression.
