CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consists of conclusion and suggestion.

1.1. Conclusion

Based on the discussion on chapter four, it concluded that this area has fulfilledthe feasibility assessment criteria for mostof components as tourism destination, the results showed three of the five components declared feasible with one of the three components, namely the amenity component was declared very feasible and for the less feasible component, namely the accessibility and activity component. With a score of each component, namely 16 on attraction, 34 on accessibility, 41 on amenities, 4 on activity and 19 on ancillary service. From the five assessment criteria, it was known that the total score is 114, which means that it was included in class II with a feasible rating as a tourism destination. However, it showed that there were still shortcomings in the development of Patra Plaju tourism village as a tourism destination, especially in the development of the accessibility component, activity and several subcomponents of amenity and ancillary service which needed development both in terms of quality and quantity.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the results of the study and conclusions, the writer proposed the following suggestions:

1. For Palembang city government

Based on the results of the study, it shows that there are still shortcomings in the development of Patra Plaju tourism village as a tourism destination, especially in the development of the accessibility

component and several sub-components of amenity and ancillary service which need development both in terms of quality and quantity. Therefore:

- a) It is hoped that the Government can help Pangan Patra Plaju tourism village to widen roads and improve road conditions by paving the road from the front gate or entrance to the house of the tempe maker, especially for the tempe maker's house which has already and adequate as a tourist attraction for tourists as well as adding clearer signage boards.
- b) It is hoped that the Government will cooperate with relevant agencies to provide the construction of supporting facilities for the convenience of tourists such as the construction of public toilets, increasing the quantity of gazebos, improving the quality of shops or souvenir shops and coordinating with the Patra Plaju tourism village management to provide accommodation or homestays for tourists.

2. For Managers at Pangan Patra Plaju tourism village

It is better if there is collaboration from government or the private sector with the management at Pangan Patra Plaju Tourism Village so that, the quality at Pangan Patra Plaju Tourism Village can be improved well, in a way such as, broaden the road conditions and be creative again about the activities that can be done at Pangan Patra Plaju Tourism Village in order to make it easier and attract tourists to visit at Pangan Patra Plaju Tourism Village.

3. For other researchers

It is expected to conduct further research on tourism development strategies in Pangan Patra Plaju tourism village in depth to increase scientific literacy and examine other potentials that are owned to be used sustainably by the community in order to improve social welfare.
