CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The writer concluded that the Elephant Training Camp was not fully fulfilled elements of tourism to become a tourism destination in Lahat South Sumatera based on *pedoman Analisis Daerah Operasi Obyek dan Daya Tarik Wisata Alam (ADO-ODTWA) Direktorat Jenderal Perlindungan Hutan dan Konservasi Alam tahun 2003*. They were attractions, facilities and infrastructure, accessibility, and accommodation. The results of the feasibility assessment of tourism elements at the Elephant Training Camp show that elements of attractions and accessibility were declared feasible, facilities and infrastructure were declared to be less feasible and accommodation was declared not feasible. With an index of 96.67% of attractions, 40% of facilities and infrastructure, 83.33% of accessibility, and 30% accommodation. For some elements like attractions, the Elephant Training Camp is less varied attraction provided in this Elephant Training Camp. For element accommodation, there was only a hotel that can be used by the tourist to stay. For elements of facilities and infrastructure, the Elephant Training Camp does not have a praying spot food court, and souvenirs shop for the tourist.

5.2 Suggestions

The writer would like to give suggestions for the Elephant Training Camp as follows:

- 1. The Administrator of the Elephant Training Camp must add various attractions like feeding the elephants, watching the elephant show playing ball, and bathing the elephants in the river.
- 2. Facilities at the Elephant Training Camp must be added such as praying spot, and food court.
- 3. The Lahat Tourism Office must have a role in the development of The Elephant Training Camp. For example, building and updating infrastructure properly,

such as road access, traffic signs, signs for tourism, and facilities at the Elephant Training Camp. Then they should carry out massive promotions using billboards, promotional videos, brochures, or booklets.
