Moreover, according to Dulay et. al as cited in Miryanti (2012, p.152), there are four types of errors. They are omission error, addition error, misinformation error, and misordering error.

In this case, Guide Book of South Sumatra was published by Indonesian and in Indonesia because we, all Indonesians including south Sumatra culture and

tourism's employees, are non-native speakers, so the possible to make errors in grammar is quite big. For instance, the writer found the word "*this pineapples are ...*" in Guide Book of South Sumatra, it is categorized as a type of misinformation error according to Dulay et. al as cited in Miryanti (2012, p.152) as quoted by Haryono.

So that is why the writer would like to choose Guide Book of South Sumatra in order to make tourists have a better understand in what south Sumatra culture and tourism office wants to describe about the tourism object.
