5.1 Conclusion

By using the two different methodologies Propp's and Torres's, the similarities show that both have elements such as opening with the character. On the other hand, the differences are also found. In Torres's framework, the elements such as theme, the style of language and the motif do not obviously appear in the Propp's functions which mainly form the whole story connected in a sequence so that it will be easier for the readers to understand the story.
