

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 CONCLUSIONS

Based on the analysis of the formulation of noun phrases found in the Tourism articles of Jakarta Post Online Newspaper, the writer conclude that there are eleven formations of noun phrases found in the Tourism articles of Jakarta Post Online Newspaper such as *determiners+n/ articles+n/ a/an/the+n*, *possesive adj+n*, *numeral (det+n_adj/number+n)*, *quantitative adj+n (det+adj+n)*, *det(+modifier)+n*, *det(modifier)+n (modifying phrase and clause)*, *det+n+to infinitive*, *det+n+relative clause*, *NP using of*, *demonstrative adjective/ this/these/that/those+n/ adj+n*. The dominant formations of noun phrases found in the Tourism articles of Jakarta Post Online Newspaper is *determiners+n/ articles+n/ a/an/the+n*. There are 240 noun phrases or 43.55% from the total amount of noun phrases found in the articles. The least formations of noun phrases that are found in the articles is *Det+n+relative clause* there is only 2 noun phrases or 0.36% in the articles. Noun phrases formations of *adverb+ participle* and *special cases* are not found in those articles, so the percentage for those noun phrases are 0%.

5.2 SUGGESTIONS

The writer would like to give suggestion to the reader especially the students of English Department to study about noun phrases especially to learn more about the formations of noun phrases. It is important to learn not only from reading books but also from other media, because it can help the reader to understand more about noun phrases so they can use noun phrase correctly in their writing and can understand more when they read the articles.
