

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The sentences are the media for delivering information in writing language form. The better way in combining the sentences is also better in understanding and accepting the information that is delivered to the readers. By the structure, sentence is classified into four types: *simple sentence*, *compound sentence*, *complex sentence*, and *compound-complex sentence*.

The analysis presents four types of sentences found in the six articles of Globe Asia magazine. They are *simple sentence*, *compound sentence*, *complex sentence*, and *compound-complex sentence*. From 88 sentences that are analyzed it is found 45 (49%) simple sentences. The most dominant formation of simple sentence is SV (single subject and single verb). For *compound sentence*, there are 16 (20%) compound sentences from 88 sentences that are analyzed. There are 26 (29%) complex sentences found in the articles. And there is only 1 (2%) compound-complex sentence found in the articles. The most dominant type of sentences is a **simple sentence**. While, a **complex sentence** is the second dominant type of sentences, the other type it is a **compound sentence** and the last is **compound-complex sentence**.
