CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents conclusion and suggestion of this report with the title "The Kinds and Functions of Kinesics Used by The Winners of The Toastmaster International Speech Contest".

5.1. Conclusion

There are only 3 kinds of kinesics that was used in the videos of the winners of the Toastmasters International Speech Contest. They are emblem, illustrator, and affect display.

The most common kinesics that was used was the illustrator. Darren La Croix used illustrator kinesics 93.33% from the total kinesics that he used, Jim Key used illustrator kinesics 90,7% from the total kinesics that he used, and Presiyan Pasilev used illustrator kinesics 71,5% from the total kinesics that he used. The second types of kinesics that mostly used was affect display Darren La Croix used affect display kinesics 5.71% from the total kinesics that he used, Jim Key used affect display kinesics 4,6% from the total kinesics that he used, and Presiyan Pasilev used affect display kinesics 23% from the total kinesics that he used. The last kinesics that was used by the winners of the Toastmasters International Speech Contest was emblem. It was the least kinesics that was used by the winners. Darren La Croix used emblem kinesics 0.95% from the total kinesics that he used in the video, Jim Key used emblem kinesics 4,6% from the total kinesics that he used, and Presiyan Pasilev used emblem kinesics 5,3% from the total kinesics that he used.

In the sample videos, illustrator kinesics mostly used to emphasize the message rather than to illustrate. Affect display kinesics was used as the need of the speech, the more dynamic the speech, the more the speech need varieties of expressions in affect display. Finally, emblem kinesics was used based on the kind of the message in the speech. If the message had both kinesics and verbal translation, the message can be sent by emblem.

5.2. Suggestion

Based on the result of the observation about kinesics used by the winners of the Toastmaster International Speech Contest, the writer suggest that students can learn about the appropriate kinesics application in public speaking. By knowing how the winner used the appropriate kinesics, students can empower their public speaking skill, and send the message that can be understood by the audience.
