

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

#### 5.1 CONCLUSIONS

After analyzing the data, the writer concludes that slang words are found in every lyric of Jay Z's songs, especially in album *Magna Carta Holy Grail*. The writer found 108 slang words. The dominant slang word found in the lyric is *Nigga* with the total of 76. Based on Patridge's classification of slang, those slang words are categorized into 5 classifications. They are *Cockney Slang*, *Society Slang*, *Public School and Universities*, *Art*, and *Slang in Church*. *Society Slang* is the majority classification found in those lyrics of songs. The lyrics in the album *Magna Carta Holy Grail* shows the voice of the young people although some of them are heard as a vulgar display of net worth. Jay Z is trying to interact with society, especially a hip-hop mainstream that has evolved a great deal.

#### 5.2 SUGGESTIONS

The use of slang words in the lyrics of Jay Z's songs is really useful. The purpose of using slang words in the lyrics of songs is to help the readers of the lyrics or even the listeners of the songs understood well about the meaning of slang words with their classification. The writer suggests the song writers who used the slang words to select slang words because seeing the meaning of slang words have really rude and impolite meaning. It is undeniable that some day slang words may affect the academic writing of the young generations. Although they can write formal language very well, they may slip one or more slang words accidentally.
