CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analyses of the changes of facilities and functions at Masjid Agung Palembang, the writer concludes that there are differences between the facilities of mosque generally and the facilities of mosque in Masjid Agung Palembang. It does not has boarding school, hospital, as-syifa, orphanage, job fair, Islamic bank, post office, bookstore, wartel and post for the disturbances and natural disasters as a good mosque. There were also the changes of the facilities a Masjid Agung Palembang that has been changed after in the year of 1774, 1980, 2003 and 2014. There are some facilities that Masjid Agung Palembang does not has as the category of Masjid Agung generally. Then, the changes were like the shapes, the sizes and the number of each facilities. The changes also happened in the function of Masjid Agung Palembang. The functions are not only the same as the function of mosque generally but also has more functions because of the facilities. So, it has four main functions the same as general function and three more functions after the last renovation in 2003. The function is not only a place for praying but also a place for conducting many other activities such as a place for organizing many kinds of Islamic competitions, a place for Islam great day celebrations and wedding celebration, and as a tourism object of cultural heritage.

5.2 Suggestion

After analyzing and finding out the changes of facilities and functions at *Masjid Agung Palembang*, the writer would like to give suggestion to the foundation and management of *Masjid Agung Palembang*. They should organize everything about the mosque well so that *Masjid Agung Palembang* improves its quality and it can has complete facilities like the other grand mosques in Indonesia. They should also promote it continuously in order many people know about *Masjid Agung Palembang* which has been as the one of famous object tourisms in Palembang. So, if it is better, the citizens of Palembang will be proud of it.
