CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Review from the travel writer who does not consider aspects of travel writings, can cause negative effects to tourists. For example, tourists read a review of the attractions in a city. In the review the travel writers describes to the readers that the tourism attraction is clean, secure and has an easy access to get to the tourism attraction, whereas the review is different from the reality. It of course, makes the tourist disappointed with the result of the review of the travel writer. Of course, it affects the hospitality industry in general and tourism in particular.

Travel writings make tourism more easily accessible to all travelers. The magnitude of the impact of travel writings helps tourists know attractions, travel writings should be made by paying attention to things that become the rule in making reviews of tourism attractions.
