CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

From the observation and interviews that have been done by the writer, it can be concluded that Kemaro island is still very low in the presentation of information about the existing of infrastructure in the Kemaro Island. For example the infrastructures such as places of worship "Hok Ceng Bio Temple" in which there is the tomb of Tan Bun Ann and Siti Fatimah. In the presentation of information that has been done by the manager and the government, which made information display look less attractive and less apparent. Even in the "Tree of Love" also does not have clear information. In addition, the information of a legend is a natural thing if there are some differences in their delivery. This is because a legend written with no certainty, then the story has been distorted (deflection) occurring among the public.

B. Suggestion

In presenting information about the place of tourism, both in terms of religious / natural amenities, should be the foundation manager of Kemaro Island or Government who participated in its management cooperation should provide / present the information as knowledge for the visitors. For example, the information can be provided through the manufacture of billboards (public sign) that are uniquely designed and attractive. By doing so the foreign and domestic visitors can find the information they need to clear. In addition, the visitors do not need to ask again about the information they want to know, either about love trees and the temple Hok Ceng Bio temple. And for us as the younger generation should be able to see the information of a legend from a different viewpoint. That in a legend, regardless of whether or not, we should be able to take lessons from every legend that happened. Similarly the legend of Kemaro Island that has been presented by Mr. Alianafiah as an expert in the history of the Palembang city, that

in the legend there are moral messages that are useful to our lives in love, cherish, and realize how much love both parents to their children.
