## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## 5.1 Conclusion

Multi-word verbs are the verb consist of a verb and a preposition and/or an adverb which have literal meaning and non-literal meaning. In Literal meaning, the meaning of the verb and particle does not change, while in nonliteral meaning, it can creates a multi-word verb that have a different meaning. Learning about multi-word verb is important for the English language learners because it is common in an everyday english features both written and spoken. Multi-word verbs is classified into three categories: *phrasal verbs*, *prepositional verbs* and *phrasal-prepositional verbs*.

The percentage of Multi-word verbs in each category are phrasal verbs is 59% prepositional verbs is 34% and phrasal-prepositional verbs is 6%.
