CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter the writer stated the conclusion and suggestions of this final report.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the findings in chapter 4, the writer concluded that the students' memorable experiences when did study excursion in Malaysia are divided into three stages according to the expert, they are pre-travel, on-site or during travel and post-travel. Their most memorable pre-travel experiences are motivation to implement the lessons into study excursion, excitement about opportunity to travel to another country, and preparing itinerary. On-site or during travel are their visited places, juxtaposition of Malaysia and Indonesia, and most impressed places that they have visited. The last one is post-travel experiences are their personal experiences (unexpected, fortuitous, and adverse) and culture shock.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions above, the writer suggested that English department must provide further information about study excursion from seniors to juniors so they can avoid undesirable things while doing study excursion. Moreover, English Department no longer used tour and travel's service but arranged it by them.
