CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the findings in chapter 4, the writer concluded that the students' memorable experiences when doing study excursion in Singapore is divided into three stages according to the expert, they are pre-travel, on-site or during-travel and post-travel. Their most memorable pre-travel experiences are about excitement, expectation, and preparing itinerary.
