CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Tourism is a travelling activity which is done by individual or group to destinations where it can give pleasure or leisure. It is relevant with Kodyat (1983) states that Tourism is traveling from one place to another, made by individuals and groups, in an attempt to find a balance or harmony of happiness with the environment in a society, culture, nature and science. The most important thing in tourism destination is tourism attraction. According to UU No. 10 Tahun 2009 about tourism, tourism destination is the geographic regions that are in one or more administrative areas in which there are public facilities, tourism facilities, accessibility, and tourist attractions. Yoeti (1985) states that tourism attraction is everything that can attract people to visit an area. To attract people to visit tourism destination, there should have something interesting such as the citizen, the culture, and natural sites that can be shown to visitors who come.

South Sumatra Province consists of some regencies and cities that have a variety of cultures. The culture itself can be heritage culture and also have the characteristics of those regencies. Beside that, culture can also be a tourism attraction in those regencies. It is because people who live in those regencies have cultures which form their way of life and this is interesting to attract visitors who like to see the uniqueness of the culture. Culture as a tourism attraction can be included as cultural tourism that attracts tourists to visit the tourism destination.

South Sumatra Province consists of many regencies that have different cultures. Penguton Dance is one of heritage cultures in Kayuagung to greet special guests. In 1959, this dance was performed to greet our first president, Soekarno, when he was visitting Kayuagung (Santoso, 2013). This dance has a unique traditional song. The number of the dancers is 9 is relate with the total of Marga in Kayuagung (Larasati, 2010).

From the explanation above, the writer chooses **"The Potency of Penguton Dance as a Cultural Tourism Attraction in Kayuagung"** as the tittle for the final report.
