

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The writer concludes that there are 333 prepositions with 31 different prepositions found in Sugeng Hariyanto storybook. The prepositions are **about, after, along, at, before, beside, between, beyond, by, down, during, for, from, in, inside, into, like, near, of, off, on, out, since, through, to, toward, under, until, up, with, without**. The types of prepositions are *simple preposition, double preposition, compound preposition, and participial preposition*. The dominant prepositions found in Sugeng Hariyanto storybook are *for, in* and *of* with the frequency of 44, 42, 58 respectively. And the least prepositions found in Sugeng Hariyanto storybook are *along, between, beyond, during, near, off, out, since, through, until, and without* with the frequency of 1 each. There are 9 categories of prepositions based on the meaning found in Sugeng Hariyanto storybook. They are **place, position; time; direction; identification; manner; agent; cause, reason, purpose; inference, motive, source, origin; and possession**.

5.2 Suggestion

The writer would like to give the suggestion to all the readers especially for the students in English Department of State Polytechnic of Sriwijaya to study more thoroughly about prepositions not only found in the storybook or novel but also in the other books or literatures, so they can use the prepositions precisely when they study English. It is also important to help the students to answer the questions related to the prepositions in TOEFL or TOEIC test.
