Taman Purbakala Kerajaan Sriwijaya is located at jln. Syakyakirti, Karanganyar village, District Gandus. The distance of this place in 30 minutes from city center.

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First it is Kedukan Bukit Inscription

The oldest remains of Sriwijaya is an evidence to the power of Sriwijaya as a maritime state. Found on the banks of the Tatang Kedukan Bukit River on 28 October 1920 by Battenberg, tells about the journey of Dapunta Hyang from Minnga Tamwan ride boat with his army, and then arrived at Mukha Upang and finally build a city of Sriwijaya by conquer some of the surrounding area. Written by using Pallawa letter with the old Malay language, and dates to the year 604 Saka or 682 AD.

Second is Sriwijaya Museum

This sriwijaya museum was built in 2008 which keeps various relics of sriwijaya kingdom, such as inscriptions, ceramics, urns, bowls and plates, this invention is believed to show how dense the daily activities of people living in this region at that time. In this museum we can also learn many history of the sriwijaya kingdom, because every inscription and site that exist in this museum is equipped with information about the relics. each description is written in the relies using two languages, there are Indonesian and

English. So every visitor who comes can read its history directly.

And the last is the Park

In Taman Purbakala Kerajaan Sriwijaya there is Cempaka Island. Visitors who come to the area of 72 hectares is not only learn the history but the visitors can make this place as a place of recreation and take pictures in Taman Pulau Cempaka. The manager provides a padlock of love, so visitors can perpetuate their love here and enjoy a relaxing time with fresh air on the swing overlooking the lake.

Therefore, Taman Purbakala Kerajaan Sriwijaya is very interesting historical tourism destination in Palembang. There are some object, for example Sriwijaya Museum, Kedukan Bukit Inscription, and the Park.
