An abstract has an important role in describing the entire section of a research report. So, it must be written well. The purpose of this research is to find out kinds of errors the students make in abstracts of final report. In conducting this research, descriptive method was used. There were 30 abstracts have been selected as the samples. The result showed that there were two kinds of kinds of errors the students made in writing abstract of final reports: errors in contents and errors in grammar. In conclusion, there were thirds of 30 abstract samples that did not have errors in contents. two-thirds left had errors in contents which can be classified into two types: errors for not writing conclusion and errors for not writing result and conclusion. Even though thirds of abstract samples did not have errors in contents, errors in grammar were still found in all of the abstract samples. The most common errors that occurred is misformation errors which appeared 33 times.
