## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## 5.1 Conclusion

Based on the findings and discussion presented in Chapter IV, the writer concluded that the sixth semester students of English Department 2017 did not know the differences between British and American English in specific subject and used both of English styles. From 20 samples, 15 samples used both of English style in chapter 1. Even some samples mixed subject like spelling in American and British English into one chapter.

The students used 57 American Spelling. but, 10 British spelling also appeared from the samples. Then, the students tend to use Present Perfect Tense in 13 sentences which is common in British English when there are 2 sentences using Simple Past Tense which is common in American English to express situation in th past. As the result, there are 74 American English style used at 20 samples and there are 37 British English style used. Even American English majority used but there are also British English style appearing from those samples.

## **5.2 Suggestion**

Based on the conclusion above, the writer suggests English department students to learn the differences between American and British English. They can learn from the book related to British and American English, check the dictionary of American-British and check the differences of grammar between both of English styles. In order to help them avoid same mistakes so that English department students use English style more consistenly for the future.
