

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### 5.1 Conclusion

In this final report, the writer concludes that Pulau Maspari has the potency to be one of tourism destinations in South Sumatera. From the four aspects that must be owned by a tourism destination, Pulau Maspari can fulfill three aspects that must be considered in tourism destinations, namely attractions of destination, transportation or accessibility, and tourism institutions that will support a feasible destination to visit. Pulau Maspari has several natural attractions, such as white sand beach, hawksbill turtles, underwater beauty of coral reefs, and a beautiful beach. The transportation used to get to Pulau Maspari is quite easy. There are two alternative transportation that can be used to get to Pulau Maspari, namely by directly using a speedboat or using a private vehicle in the form of a car first and then using a speedboat. Access roads that are passed by private vehicles are also quite good. At present, Pulau Maspari is managed by *Dinas Kelautan dan Perikanan Provinsi Sumatera Selatan* and *Dinas Kebudayaan dan Pariwisata Provinsi Sumatera Selatan*. This tourism destination which was just inaugurated in February is still in the development stage of the two institutions. Whereas there is still one aspect of tourism that has to be fulfilled by Pulau Maspari, which is main and supporting facilities. So far, there are no supporting facilities such as hotels or inns, restaurants, public toilets, tourist information centers, security posts, and souvenir shops on the island.

#### 5.2 Suggestion

The writer gives some suggestion related with the aspect of transportation and the aspect of main and supporting facilities to develop Pulau Maspari as a tourism destination in South Sumatera as follows:

1. The Local Government should provide special transportation to Pulau Maspari which later can facilitate direct access of tourists to go to this island.

2. The Local Government should make the main facilities in the form of hotels or inns on Pulau Maspari, so that tourists who come can stay longer and feel safer.
3. The Local Government should make supporting facilities such as restaurants, public toilets, tourist information centers, security posts, and souvenir shops on Pulau Maspari.
4. The Local Government should provide or make rental equipment for diving equipment to support tourist attractions on Pulau Maspari.
